

Use of logos and disclaimer for Erasmus+ beneficiaries

Project beneficiaries are required, as part of their project communication activities, to display the EU emblem and include the disclaimer on all communication materials. This factsheet provides an overview of the correct use of the EU emblem and the disclaimer.

EU emblem and disclaimer

All recipients of EU funding are legally required to explicitly acknowledge the support received from the European Union in all communication materials. This ensures that the project is visibly recognised as being implemented with financial support from the EU. The use of the EU emblem and the disclaimer is mandatory for all communication and dissemination activities. Recipients of EU funding must comply with the obligations laid down in Article 17 of their grant agreement. This includes, in particular, the correct placement of the EU emblem and the disclaimer on all publications.

EU emblem

The EU emblem has to be displayed prominently and correctly. The following rules apply:

- Whenever possible, the EU emblem shall be used in the national language.
- No other logos may be placed directly next to the EU emblem.
- The text «Co-funded by the European Union» has to be written out in full.
- Either the horizontal or the vertical version of the logo may be used.
- The minimum height of the EU emblem is 10 mm.

Disclaimer

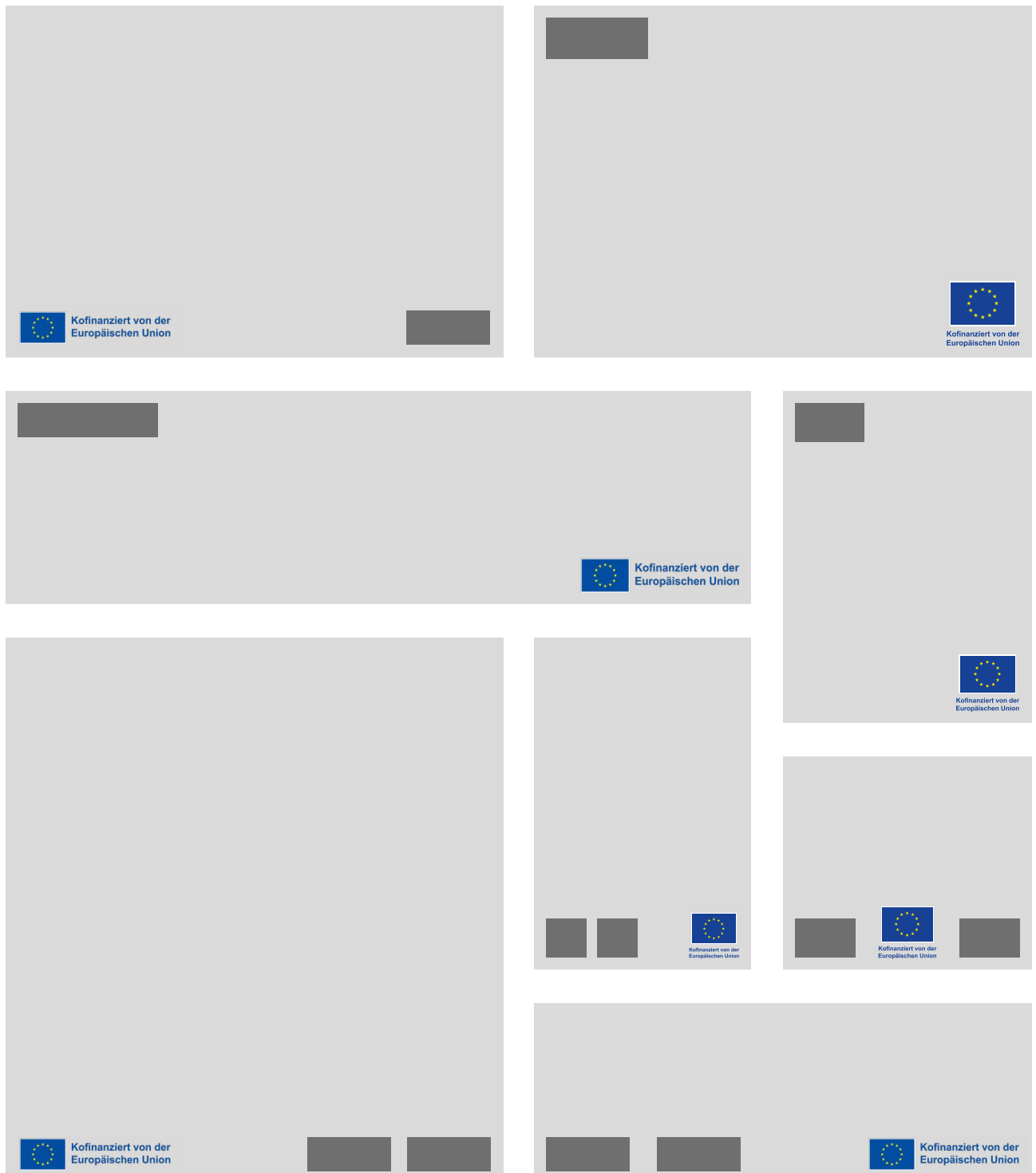
The disclaimer must be included unchanged on all communication materials:

Placement of logos

The examples below illustrate how logos, and in particular the EU emblem, should be positioned. If other logos are placed in addition to the EU emblem (e.g. Erasmus+, sponsors, partner logos, etc.), the EU emblem must be displayed at least as prominently and visibly as the other logos.



Logo Erasmus+

The Erasmus+ logo may be used in addition to the EU emblem, but is not mandatory. The Erasmus+ logo refers to the EU programme. It may be used either left-aligned or centred.
